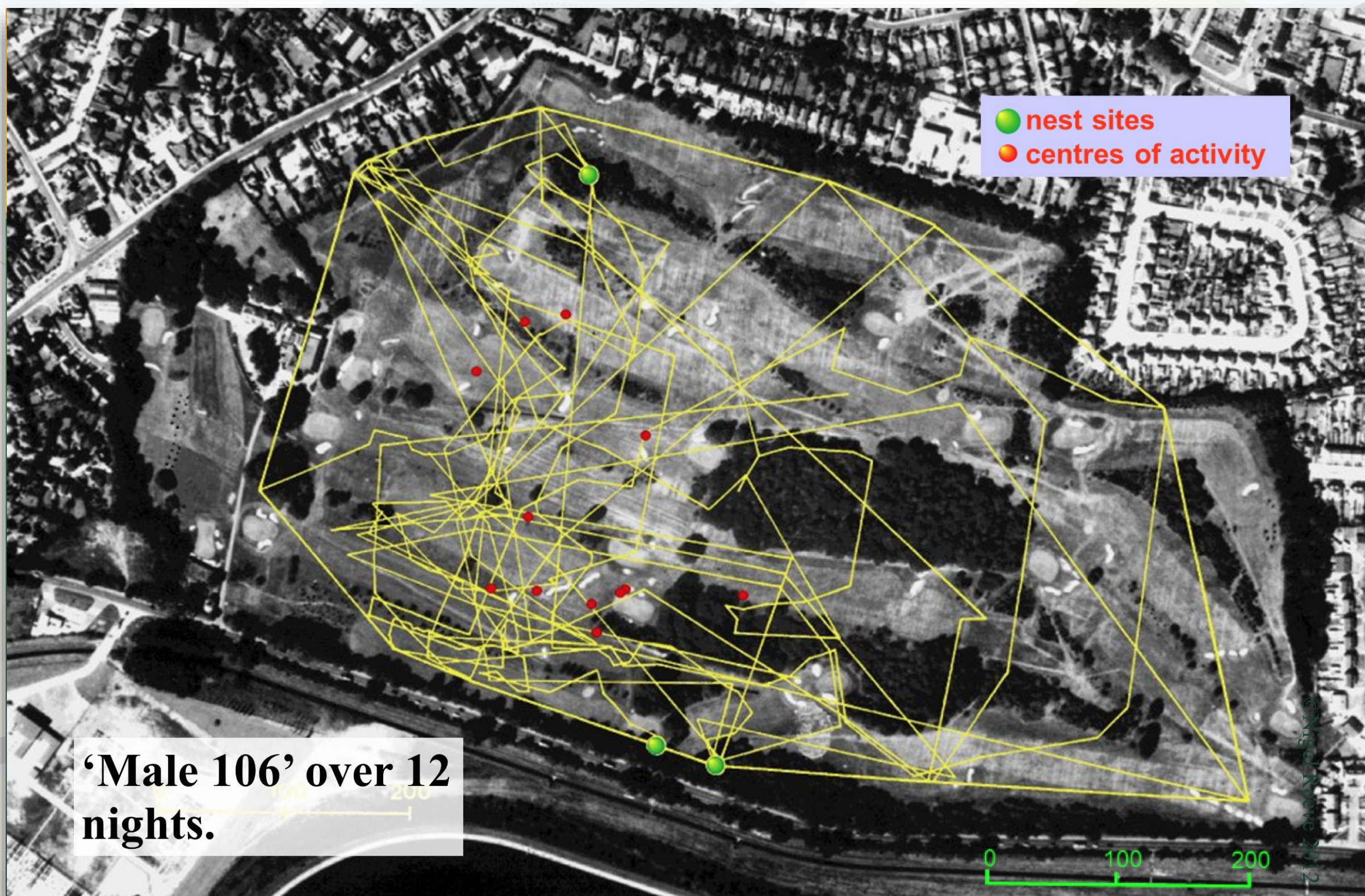

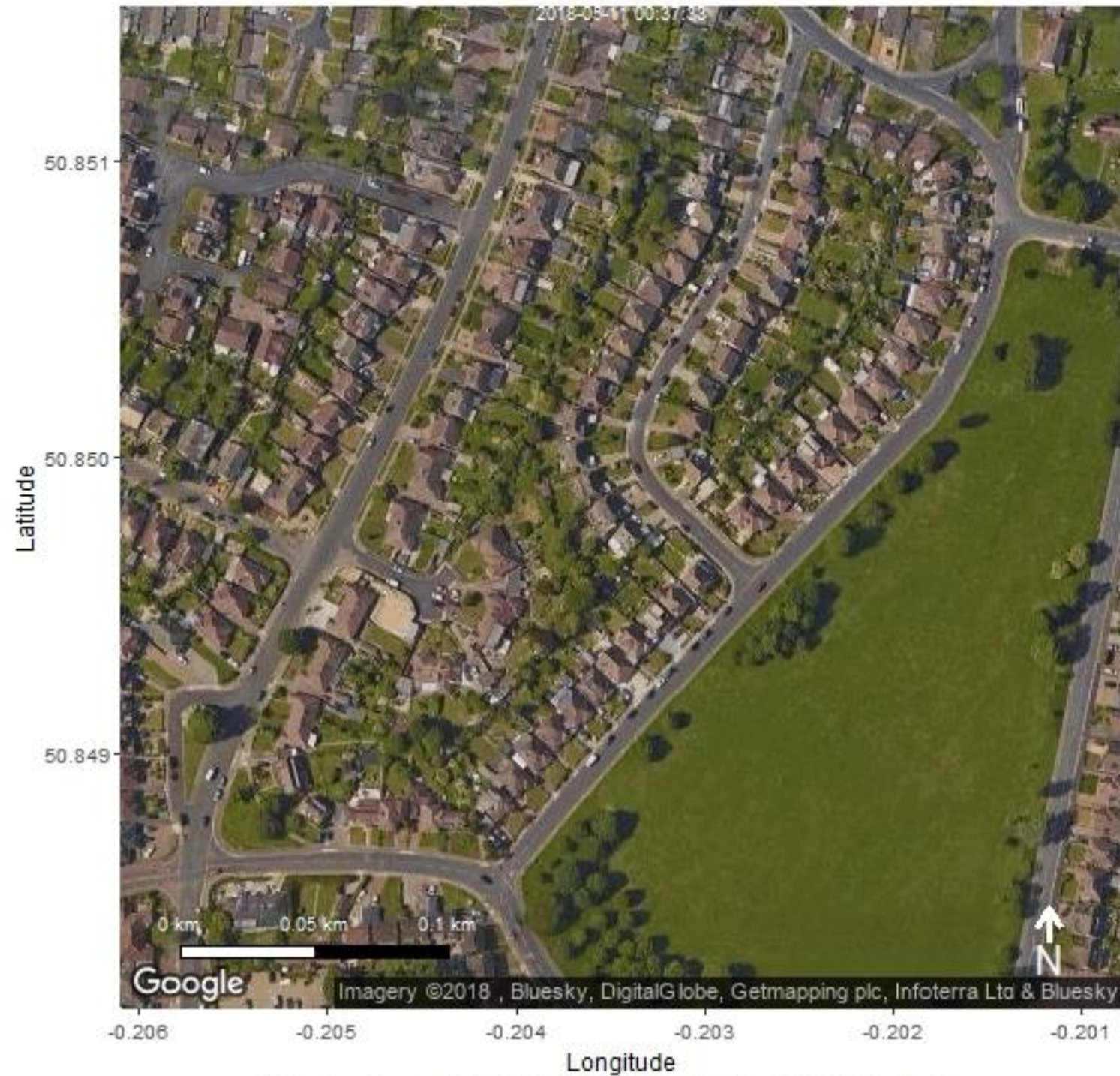


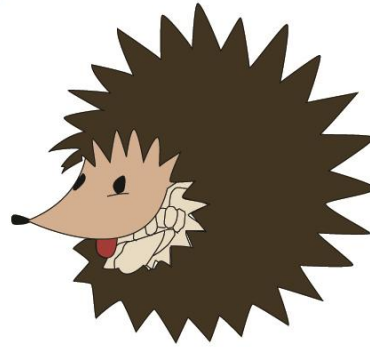


Movement of hedgehogs in Brighton 2018
